- The solution can be useful for an individual, the government, Non-governmental organisations, etc.
- The paper has to be concise and well-researched with evidence for the problem, with explanations of the solution suggested or proposed.
- This explanation needs to be supported by a base study (*where applicable*).

Criteria:

- Open for participants aged 18 – 40 years old
- This is an open contest with only one category
- Each entry (either individual or a team of no more than 5 persons) may submit their applications
- Number of words: 1000 to 3000 words only
- Language: English
- online training will be provided

- 3 Silver Awards: **RM1,000 per winner**
- 4 Bronze Awards: **RM500 per winner**
