

- IS AFC REPLACING SCIENCE FAIR FOR YOUNG CHILDREN (SFYC) OR YOUNG INVENTORS CHALLENGE (YIC)
 NO. AFC is a different programme launched during the COVID-19 outbreak. SFYC and YIC will be conducted as per its own method.
- 2. IS AFC ONLY FOR STUDENTS? NO. Parents, Teachers and elders can also participate. The age category is determined by the participant that appear in the video. We highly encourage retired teachers to participate in category 3.
- 3. HOW MANY PARTICIPATIONS OR VIDEOS CAN A SCHOOL SEND OR PER TEAM SEND?

Each team can only send 3 video with different concepts. A school can submit more than 1 team, but with different concept.

- 4. CAN ONLY TEACHERS PARTICIPATE? YES. Teachers can participate under Category 3.
- **5.** DOES THE VIDEO HAS TO BE IN ENGLISH? Your video can be either in English or Malay or Tamil language.
- 6. DOES THE VIDEO NEED TO MEET CERTAIN DURATION OR CAN BE AS LONG AS WE LIKE?

The Video should be a maximum of 5 minutes long.

- 7. DO WE NEED TO DO EXPERIMENT OR INVENTION? You need to invent something simple that teaches a scientific principles of your choice. It can be a new experiment or even a method of teaching. Your way of teaching can be new which are not used normally.
- MUST MY INVENTION BE A PRODUCT? Not necessarily, it can also be a new way of teaching the concept – e.g. you can create/ "invent" a story to explain a concept.
- 9. DO WE NEED TO PAY? There is no cost for participating in AFC. It is totally free.
- 10. WHAT KIND OF TOPICS CAN TERTIARY STUDENTS PRESENT FOR AFC? Anything like Navier strokes equation for chemistry of engineering students, or Quantum Entanglement for physics student or GDP for economic student. But it must



be simple so that everyone can understand. For a tertiary students, the concepts can be outside of STEM.

- 11. DEADLINE FOR VIDEO SUBMISSION? Check our website for the latest deadline update.
- 12. HOW TO UPLOAD VIDEO? Refer our AFC Module 5.
- 13. CAN I PARTICIPATE INDIVIDUALLY? Your team should consist of a minimum of 2 and maximum of 5 participants only. There is no individual participation.
- 14. WHAT IS THE AGE CATEGORY? AFC is divided into 3 age-based categories, which are; C1: 10-12 years, C2: 13-17, C3:

Above 18 years old. The age category is determined by the eldest person appearing in the video.

- **15. DO YOU ALLOW CHANGES IN GROUP MEMBERS?** You may change it during Video Submission, Key in new member's name in video submission form and inform of your changes.
- 16. DO YOU ALLOW CHANGES IN TEAM NAME? Email us your old team's name and new name to AFC at astifeynman2020@gmail.com
- 17. IS IT MUST TO USE RECYCLE MATERIAL FOR THE INVENTION? No, but you are encouraged. No marks consideration here, but it is always good to be socially and environmentally responsible.
- **18.** CAN A SCHOOL SUBMIT MANY VIDEOS EXPLAINING SAME SCIENTIFIC CONCEPT? No. If you are representing a school, the teams must explain different concepts.

19. DO I NEED TO REPRESENT MY SCHOOL?

AFC is a team-based competition. You can represent your school, your family, any organisation or just your team.

20. Where can I describe my invention? You do not need to describe the invention in your video, you can describe it in the description section of youtube.
